





TAXPAYER IMPACT STATEMENT- FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027

(Required under Texas Government Code § 551.043 as amended by HB 1522)

This statement is provided to inform the public of the potential property tax impact of the proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2026–2027. The comparison is based on the median-valued homestead in Baylor County, Texas.

Comparison Scenario	Tax Rate (per \$100)	Estimated Property Tax Bill
Current Year Tax Rate (2025)	\$0.20000	\$153.26
Proposed Tax Rate (2026)	\$0.20000	\$162.44
Estimated Taxes Under No-New-Revenue Rate	\$0.17311*	\$140.60

Calculation Data for Median Homestead:

- **Current Median Taxable Value (2025):** \$76,632.00
- **Upcoming Median Taxable Value (2026):** \$81,217.50

**The 2026 no-new-revenue rate was not available at the time that this document was prepared; therefore, the 2025 no-new-revenue rate was used for this calculation.*

Summary:

If the Baylor County Hospital District adopts the proposed tax rate of \$0.20000 per \$100 valuation, the average homestead owner would pay approximately \$21.84 more annually compared to the no-new-revenue tax rate.
